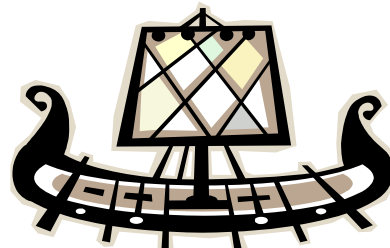
# Ulnes Walton

Waleton, 1203, 1301; Ulveswalton, 1284;  
Ulfneswalton, 1320; Ulneswalton, 1321

## **There are two schools of thought about the origin of the name ULNES WALTON**

The first was that it was named after a Viking named ULF who built a settlement at the maximum navigable reach of the River Lostock. And it was known as "ULF's WALLED TOWN ". The fact that there is a large village in Norway called "ULNES" does lend some credence to this theory.

The other option is that the manor of ULNES WALTON was a member of the fee or barony of Penwortham. Of the lord of Penwortham it was held by the service of the fifth part of a knight's fee by a family surnamed Walton. The earliest known member of it, Ulf de Walton, was living about 1160, and he no doubt gave the distinguishing name of Ulf's (Ulnes) to the township.
